General College Application Steps:

- 1. Sept-Oct: Student completes online college application (see below for links).
- 2. If a transcript is needed, Students must follow these steps to request a transcript from EHS. On the Naviance home page, click on Colleges I am applying to, click the plus button and fill in accordingly.
- If requested, send ACT scores by logging in at this link
