Subject: *Cet FAFSA ready!* Create your StudentAid.gov account NOW.

Now is the time for students and parents to create <u>StudentAid.gov</u> accounts to file the FAFSA.

The 2025–26 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) opens Dec. 1, 2024. Filing the form is essential to be eligible for grants, scholarships, work-study, and loans.

Here's how to be ready:

- 1. <u>Create your StudentAid.gov account</u>.
- 2. If you're a <u>dependent student</u>, a parent must create an account as well.

Checklist for Account Creation:

- Name as it appears on your Social Security Card.
- Date of birth.
- Personal email. Use one you will keep long-term as you will use it repeatedly.
- Social Security Number (SSN) if you have one. If not, see below.

Need an account for a parent? Check if one is required. If you're a dependent student, the "<u>Who's My FAFSA Parent</u>" tool can help.

No SSN? Parents without SSNs will create accounts by selecting "What if I don't have a Social Security Number?" Do not use an ITIN in place of SSN. <u>This handout</u> may be helpful.
