## **2025 Summer School Contract**

### **(Optional for Grades 10-12)**

Elkhorn Public Schools offers three summer school courses for upperclassmen. The courses offered are **Personal Finance/Careers Online**, **IT Fundamentals Online**, and **Healthy Lifestyles (PE) Summer**. Taking a summer class opens a student's schedule for elective classes during the school year.

The decision to enroll in a summer course must be a family decision, with consideration given to the student's and family's schedule and other time commitments over the summer. It is important to evaluate your student's schedule to determine if summer school is a consideration for your student due to strict attendance and assignment submission policies (see attached contracts for specific details). Most students should be able to fit in all required and elective courses into their school day **without** needing to consider summer school.

Students are not guaranteed placement in courses, as space is based on the availability of resources. In the event of more students than spaces, placement will be determined by principals with consideration given to student schedules. If a spot is unavailable, students will have priority the following summer if requested. **There is no fee for these classes.**

Students and parents must submit a signed contract, which outlines rules and expectations for participation in the course, in order to register for these courses.

**Contracts must be returned to Elkhorn High School by February 12th, in order to be considered for summer school.**

Career components will also be incorporated into this internet-based class.

## HEALTHY LIFESTYLES SUMMER (Grades 10-12)

This summer course is designed for students who wish to enhance their personal health and fitness through a variety of field trips, fitness activities as well as team, individual and recreational activities. Students will spend half of the course time involved in physical activities which will include weight training, cardio training, core and flexibility training along with games that can be incorporated into a lifelong fitness program. The health component will include areas of personal fitness, weight management, nutrition, digestive health, first aid and athletic training.
