Note from the Nurse...



Thank you for keeping your child home when they don't feel well. **CHILDREN SHALL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL**

FOR THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- Contagious diseases such as chickenpox, measles, mumps, pink eye, etc.
- Skin eruptions or suspicious rash
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Abnormal temperature (Elkhorn Public Schools

complies with the Douglas County Health Department recommendation that a child may not stay at school if temperature is 100 degrees or more and should not return to school until fever-free for 24 hours.)

- Head lice

A child absent from school because of a skin disease or other infectious or contagious disease may be required to present a statement from a doctor upon returning to school.

-Health Screens-

If your student received a referral letter after health screenings, please follow-up with the appropriate health care provider and return completed referral forms to the school. Referrals are meant to bridge the gap between regular health check-ups.

It's not too early to start scheduling your school and sports physicals!



- o Students who will be entering **Kindergarten** in the fall or who are **new students from out of state** will need to submit a **physical exam and vision exam (including tests for strabismus, amblyopia, and acuity)** dated **no earlier than February 13th, 2025**, as well as a current

immunization record including the Kindergarten booster shots. Here is the

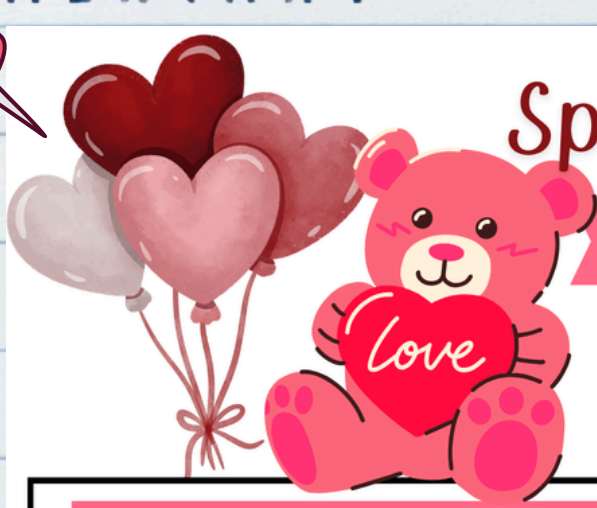
