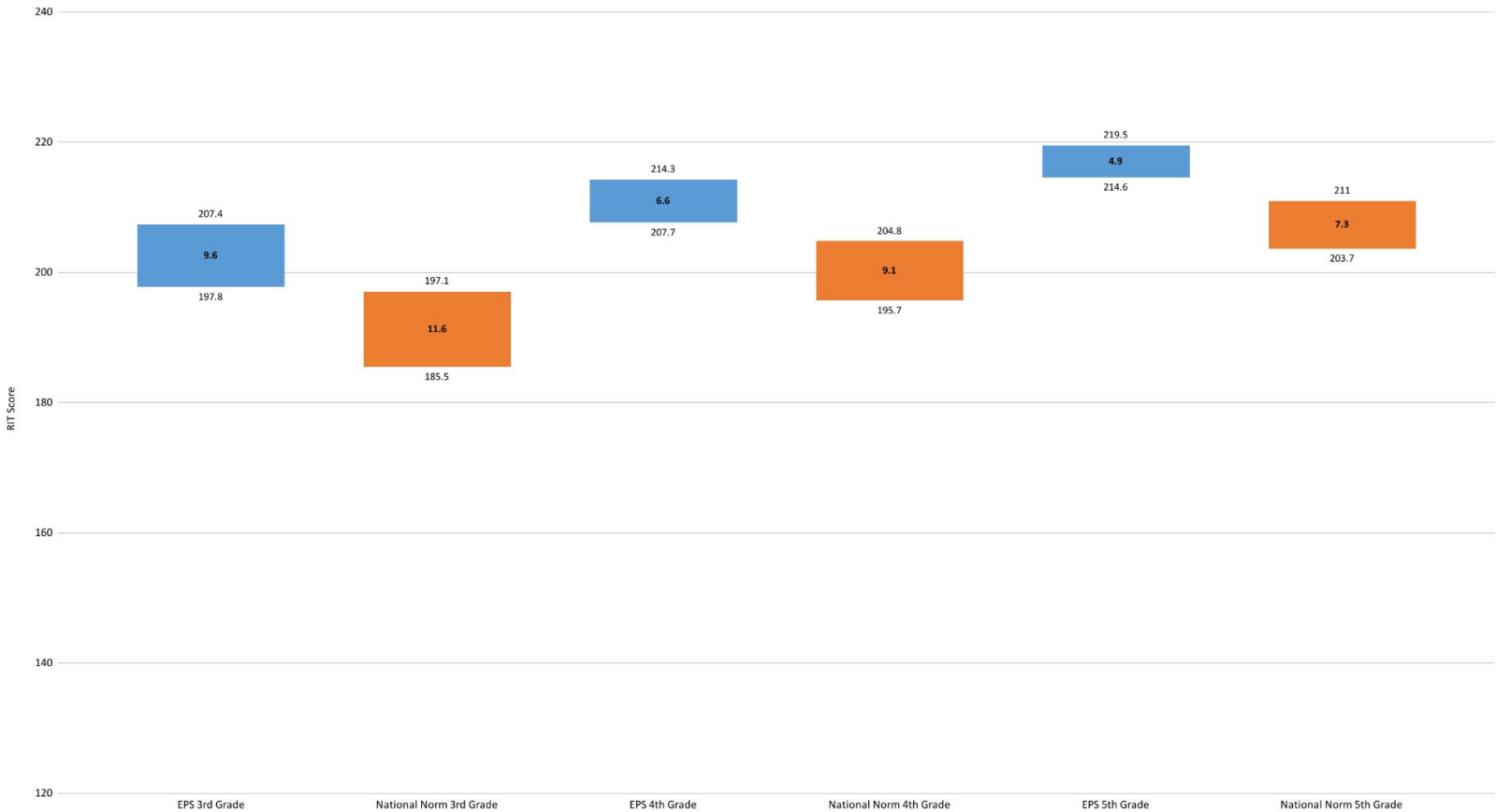

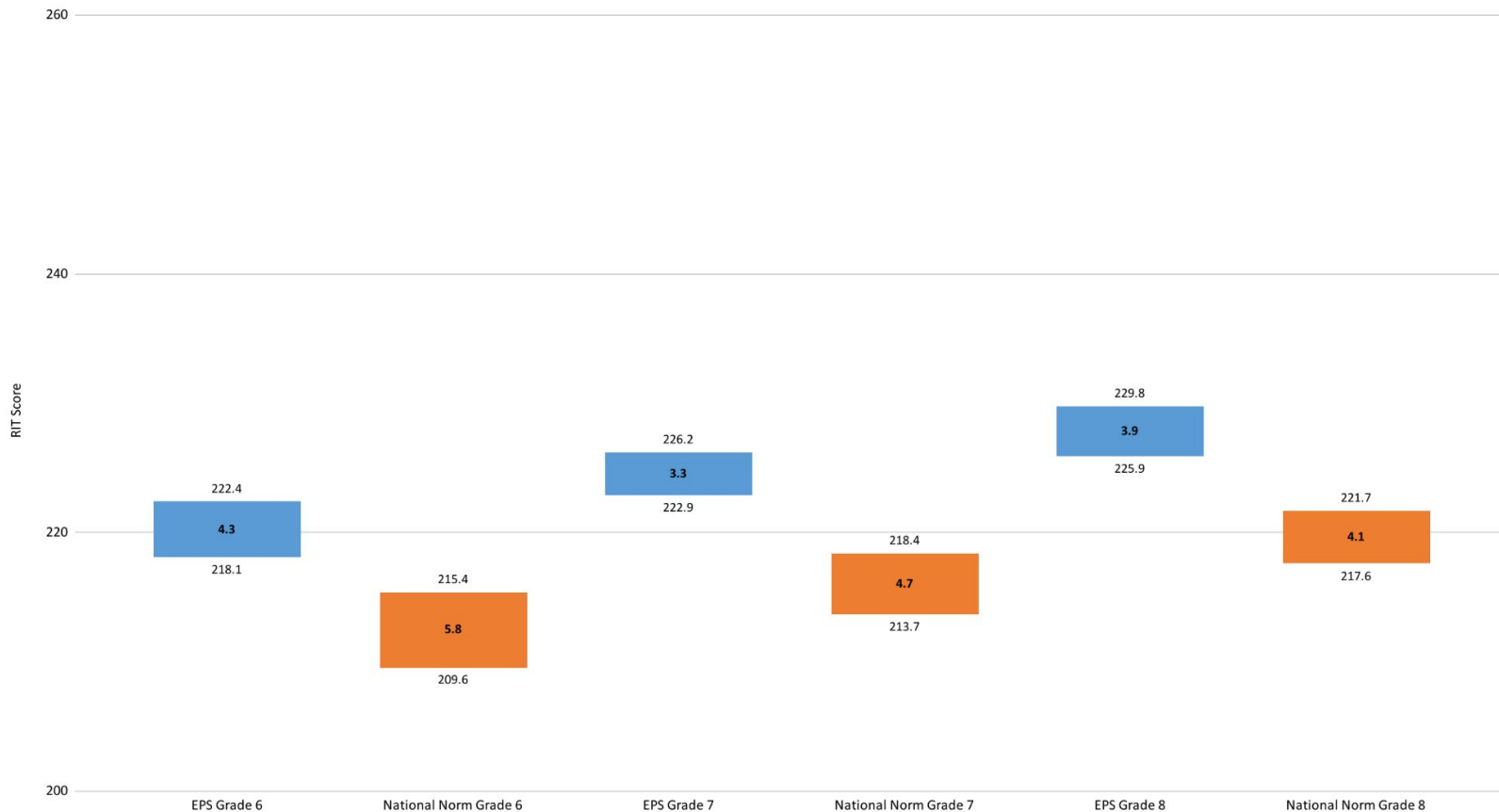

EPS & National Norm Growth Score Comparison for 2024-25 Fall to Spring MAP Math Test

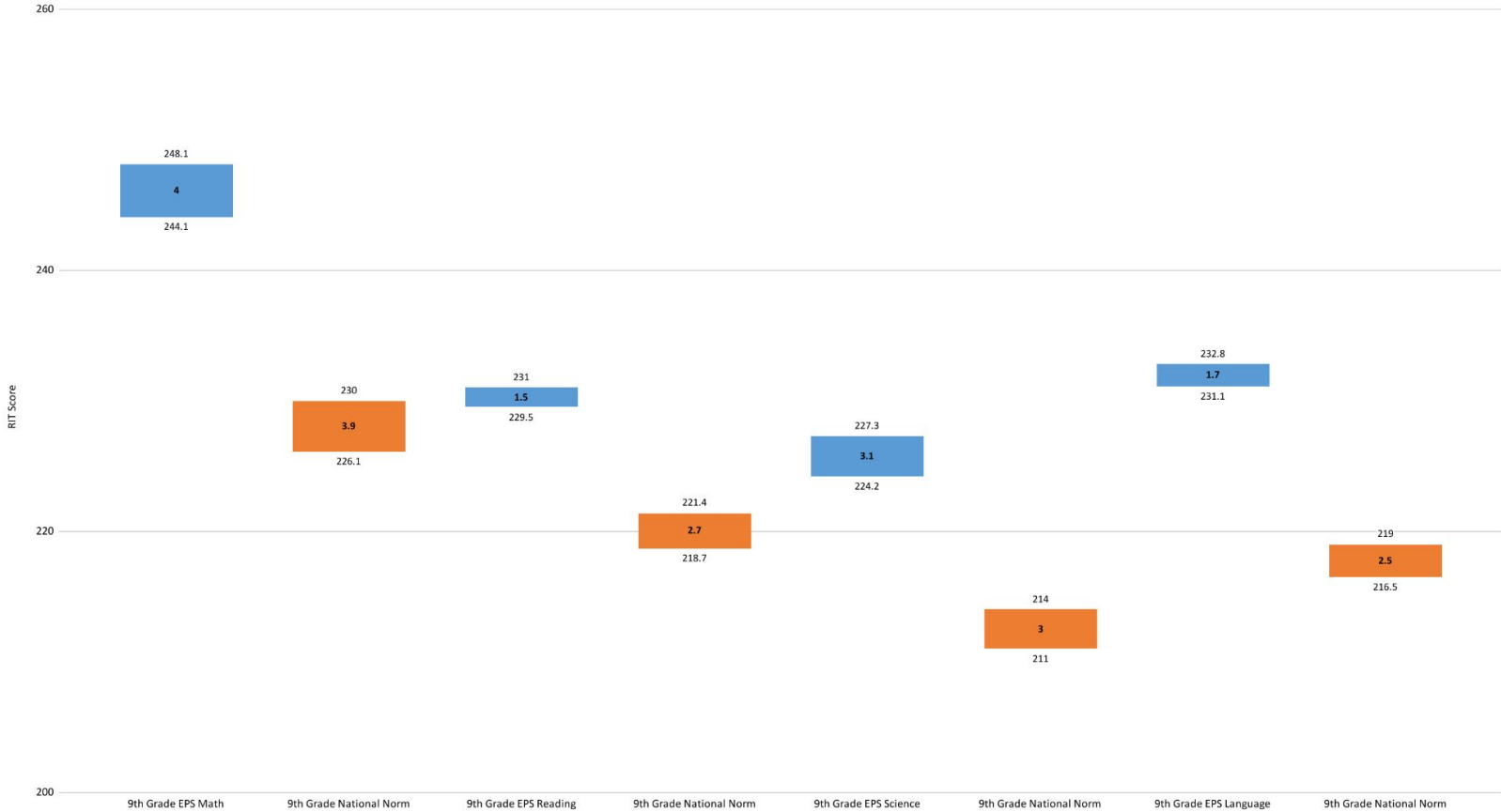


EPS & National Norm Growth Score Comparison for 2024-25 Fall to Spring MAP Test - Math



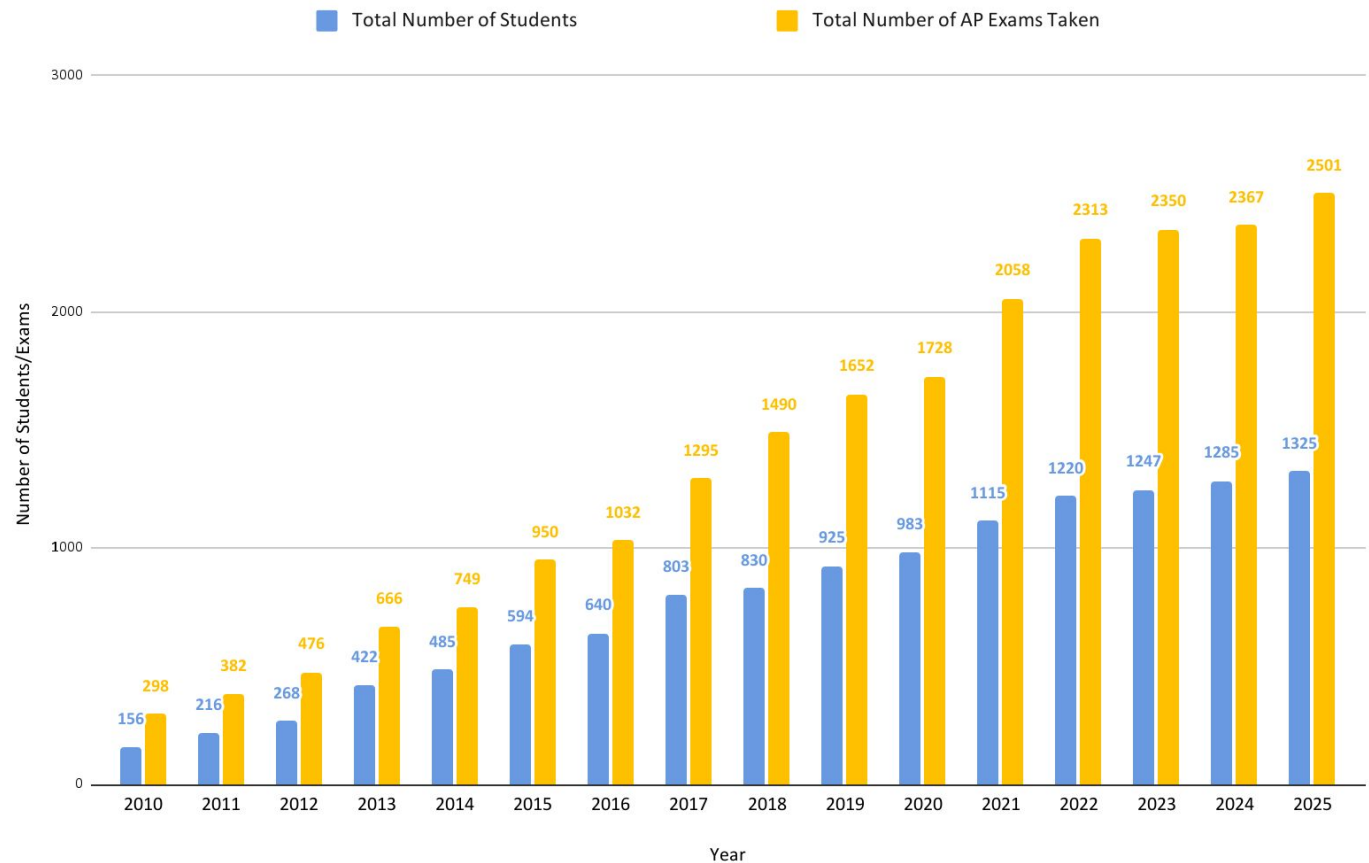

9th Grade EPS & National Norm Growth Score Comparison for 2024-25 Fall to Spring MAP Tests



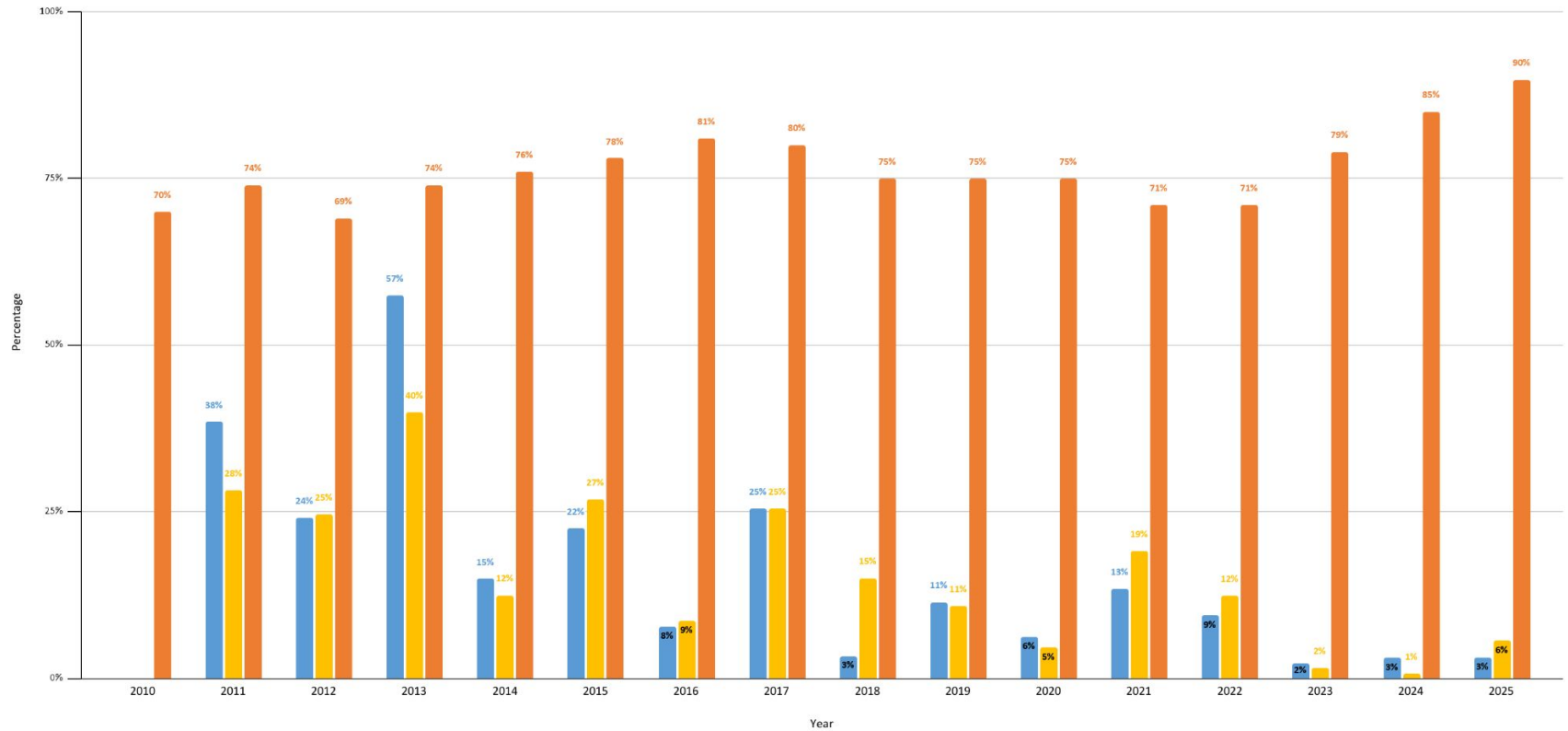

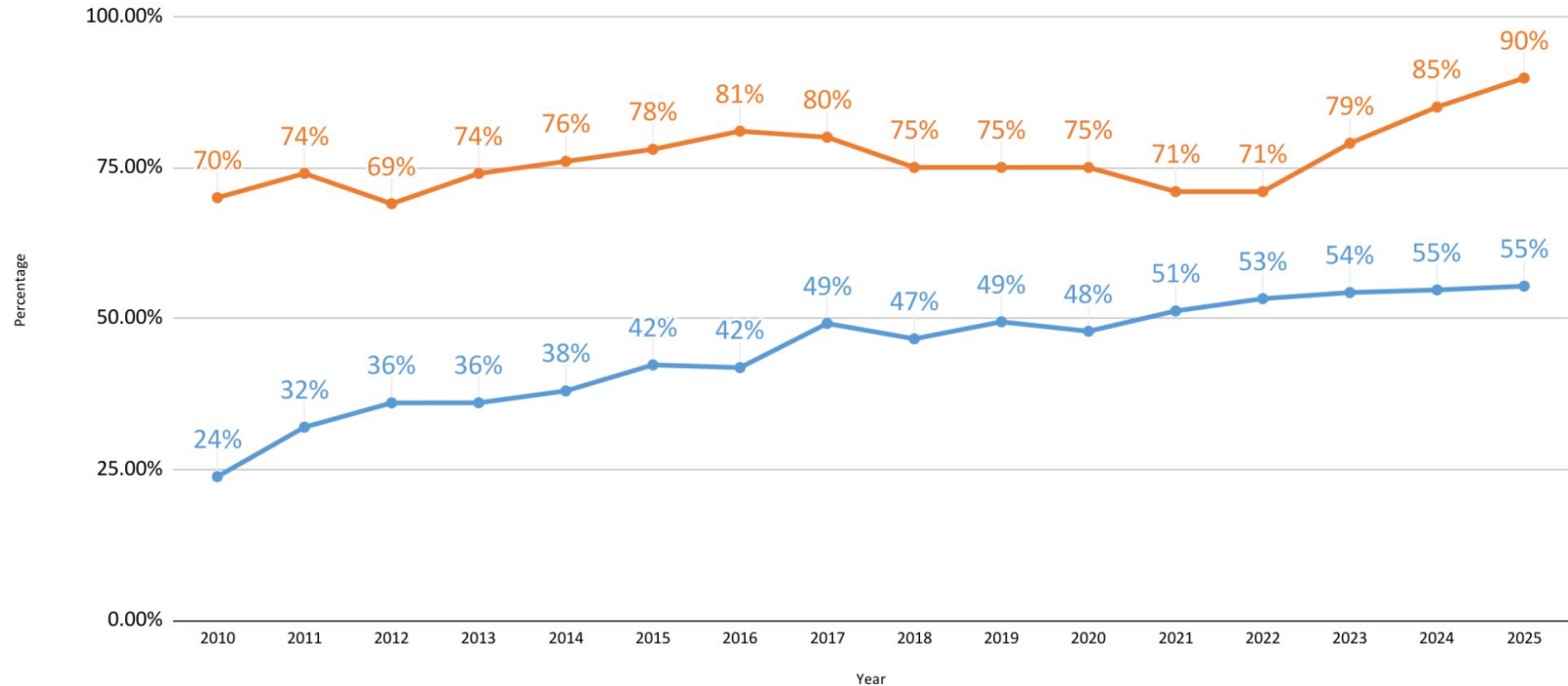

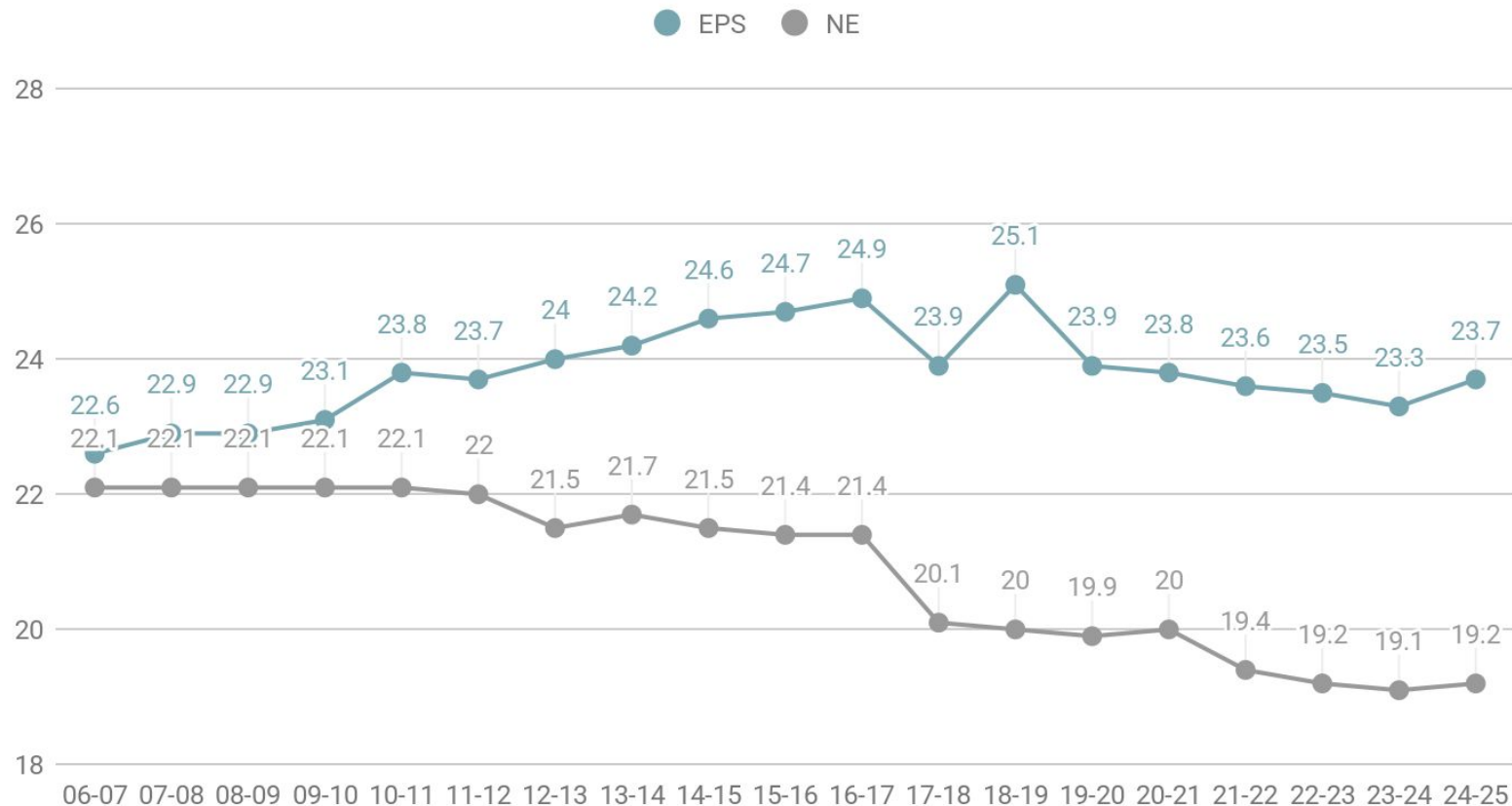
- Percentage of Students (at Grades with AP Courses) Taking an AP Exam
- Percentage of Exams With a Score of 3 or Higher

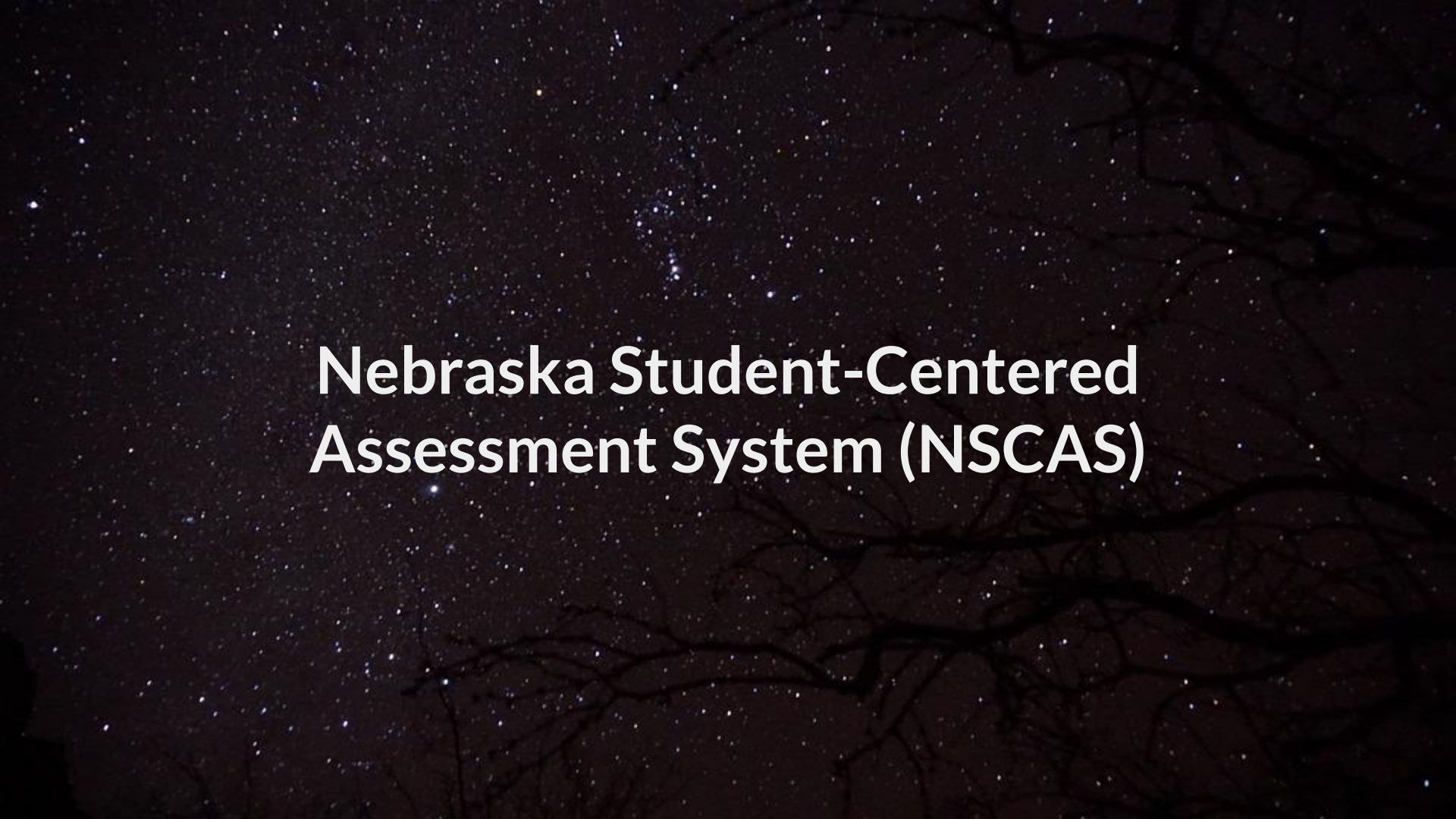




ACT Graduate Report 2025

ACT Composite Trend for Graduating Seniors





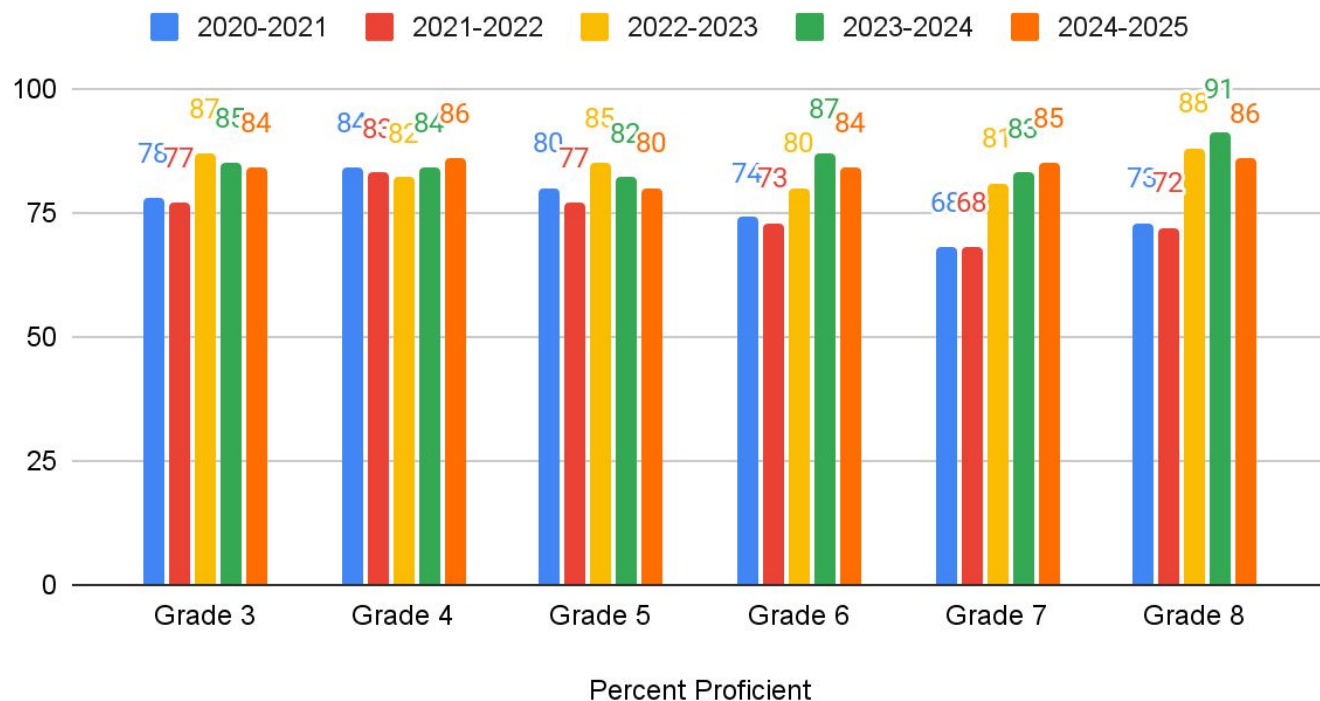
Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System (NSCAS)

Nebraska State Accountability Testing

- The Nebraska Department of Education had been moving to a through-year testing model, which resulted in changes to the state NSCAS test administered in ELA and Math in Grades 3-8.
- The NSCAS - ELA reflects the standards that were adopted by the Nebraska State Board of Education in 2022. New cut scores were set based on the updated assessment in summer 2023.

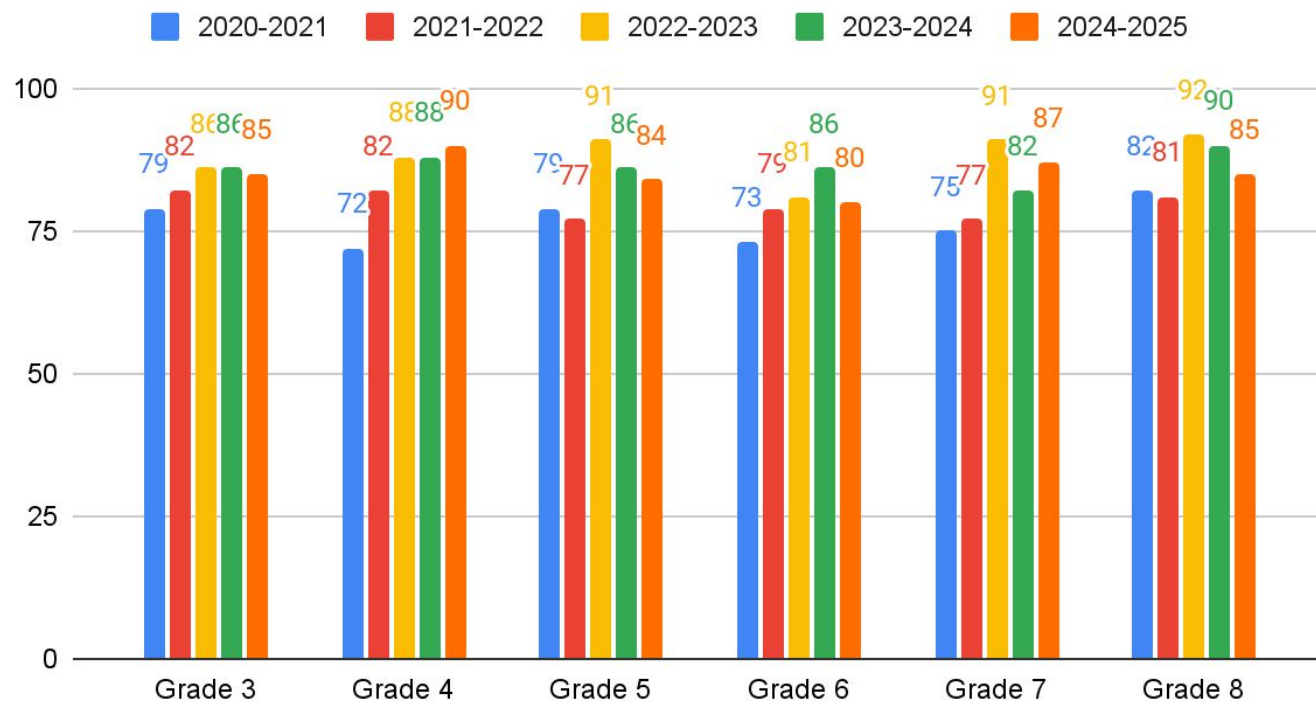
NSCAS ELA Percent Proficient Grades 3-8

NSCAS Growth ELA Percent Proficient



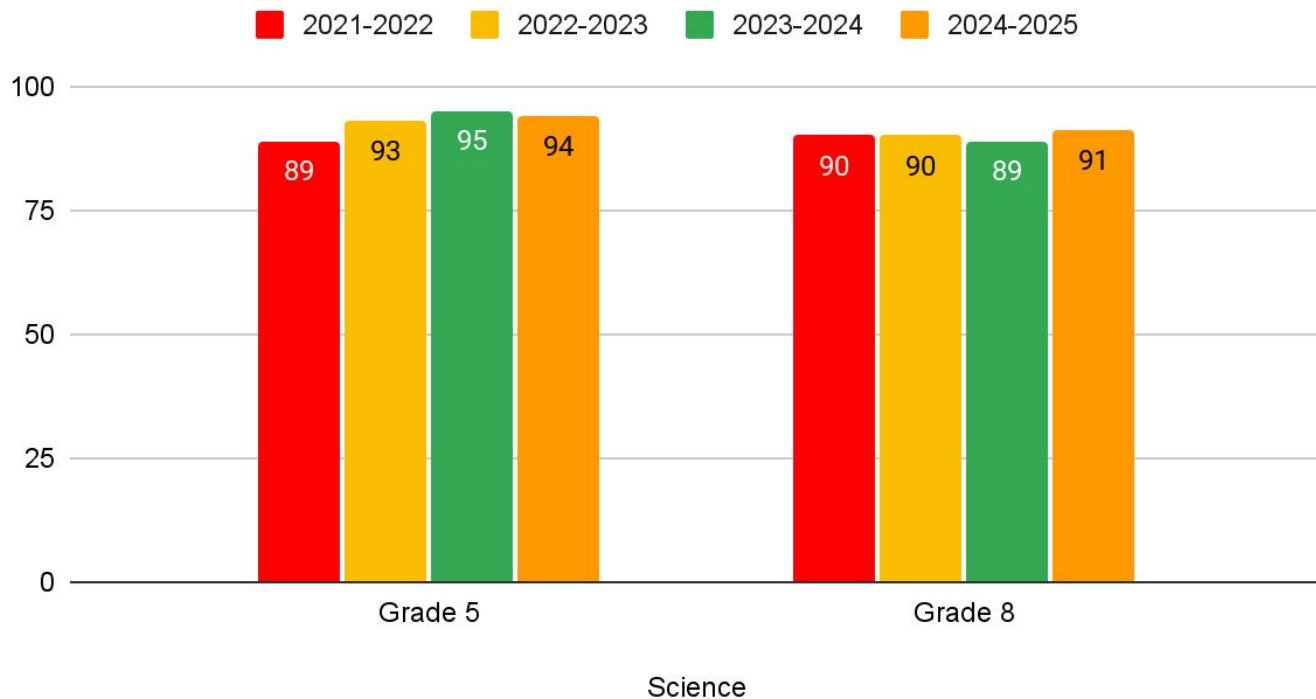
NSCAS Math Percent Proficient Grades 3-8

NSCAS Science Percent Proficient Grades 5 & 8

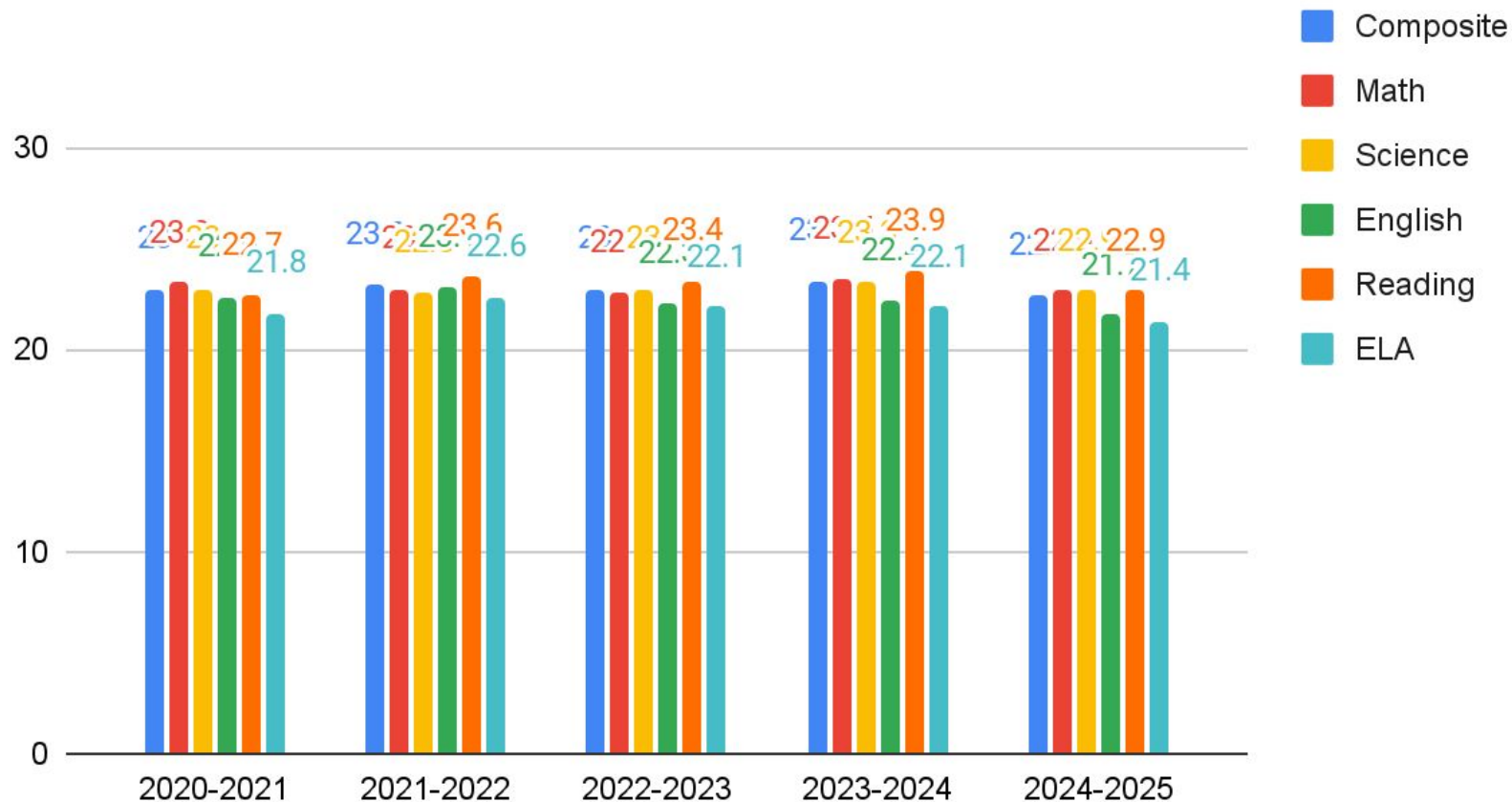

State ACT - Grade 11

- The district reports two different ACT scores
 - Scores for Graduating Seniors
 - Scores for the Grade 11 State Test administration of the ACT
- The ACT Graduate report is based on the last ACT that the student took prior to graduation.
- The State ACT test is administered to all students in Grade 11 within a month-long window in the spring.

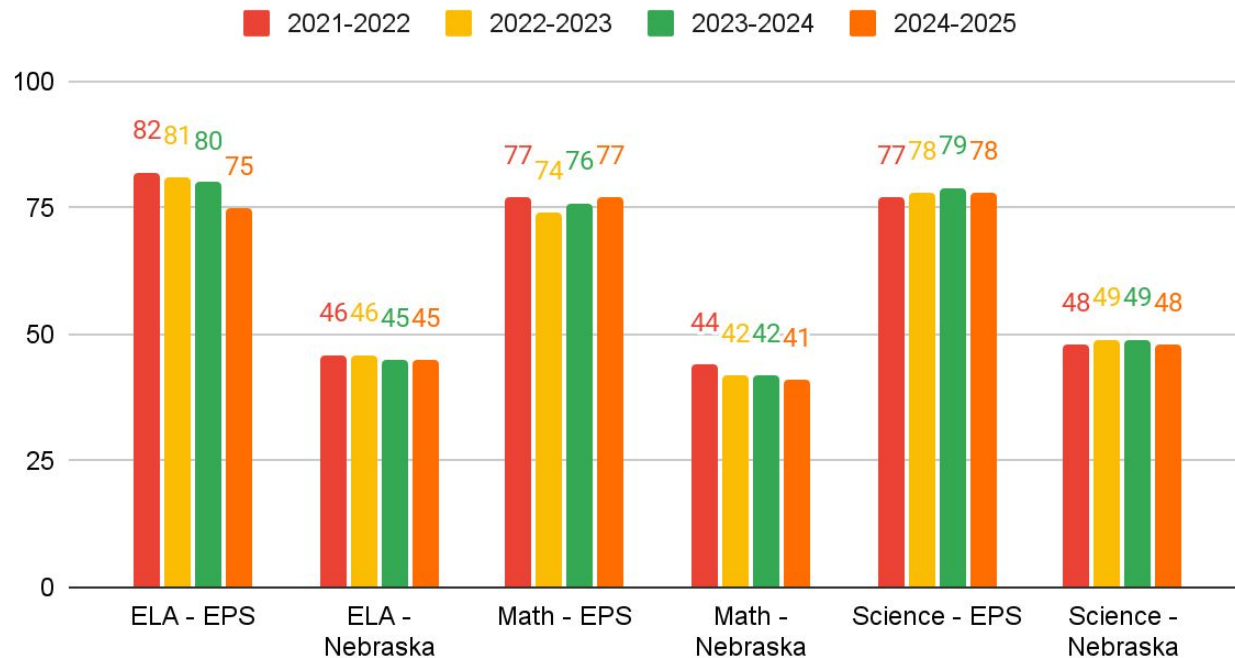
EPS State ACT Score, 2020-21 through 2024-25

Accountability for a Quality Education System, Today and Tomorrow (AQuESTT) District Rating

AQuESTT Ratings

- AQuESTT Ratings were given at the district and school levels. Ratings include data about student performance on NSCAS ELA, Math, Science, ACT, graduation rate, chronic absenteeism, and progress toward EL proficiency.
- Elkhorn Public Schools received an **Excellent** rating as a district. EPS has received an **Excellent** rating since AQuESTT was first implemented. All of the individual schools received **Excellent** ratings as well.



Computer Science Graduation Requirement

LB 79-3305 Annual Computer Science and Technology Report

LB 79-729 added a graduation requirement for students the Class of 2028 to complete a five credit course in computer science and technology.

Elkhorn Public Schools students can meet this requirement by completing one of the following courses:

- IT Fundamentals
- Programming
- AP Computer Science
